School News

Red Class

Red Class have been enjoying exciting sensology activities, exploring different coloured lights and sensory objects whilst developing their visual attention, fine motor skills and muscle strength. We have also been getting creative with paint, decorating our London themed bunting. It has been wonderful to see the children so engaged and enthusiastic in their learning!



Yellow Class

This week in Yellow Class we said goodbye to our butterflies which we have been looking after since they were caterpillars. We released them in the sensory garden. We then made our own butterfly collages in art. In cooking we've been making fruit salad which has been brilliant for practising our choice making and fine-motor skills.



Dragonfly Class

This week, Dragonfly Class continued learning about London landmarks through sensory stories. The children also enjoyed a sensory cooking session where we made guacamole by exploring all the ingredients and mixing them to create a new texture. We celebrated World Rivers Day by creating a collage for the class.



Pink Class

This week in Pink Class, the children enjoyed participating in an experiment. The children used bicarbonate of soda and vinegar to create a reaction. They used droppers to add the vinegar into the tray and their hands to explore the mixture whilst it fizzed. They enjoyed watching and listening to the mixture as it reacted.



Blue Class

This week in Blue Class, we had lots of fun in our cooking lesson. We continued to learn about measuring and talked about how much flour we needed. We mixed our ingredients together and used a rolling pin, brush and spoon, helping us to develop our fine motor skills. We had a lovely time making our jam tarts and enjoyed exploring the different ingredients. The children were very excited to see and taste what they had made!



Orange Class

This week Orange Class have been busy working on lots of different activities. We enjoyed making a London skyscraper scene using Numicon and paint. We were inspired by our story 'Paddington' to make our own sandwiches, although we used cucumber and jam instead of marmalade! We also enjoyed our sensory exploration of different foods in our Fun with Food session.



Bumblebee Class

This week Bumblebee Class started exploring the topic of 'London', creating our own red London bus and Big Ben clock to display in our role play room! In their literacy learning, pupils explored the story of 'The Queen's Hat' by using their senses to travel through London and correctly matching new vocabulary. In our maths learning, some pupils explored counting along with nursery rhymes whilst others looked at the different ways to represent numbers to 10. The pupils also made marshmallow cereal squares in cooking and took part in a fizzy experiment where they made a rocket!



Gold Class

Gold Class have had a fantastic week focusing on their attention and looking skills! We turned into urban explorers, focusing on London landmarks and buildings to spot. The pupils carefully followed a multi-step recipe to prepare a traditional cucumber and butter sandwich. This activity provided an excellent opportunity to develop independent life skills, including precise spreading and cutting.



Green Class

This week, Green Class have enjoyed taking part in lots of exciting sensory activities. During our sensory food session, we explored a range of red foods, including strawberry mousse and beetroot. The pupils particularly enjoyed exploring the beetroot, moving it around the tray and observing as it left colourful residue marks behind. We also had lots of fun exploring foil during our sensology session. The pupils enjoyed investigating its shiny appearance, crinkly sound and interesting texture.



Rainbow Class

We have been enjoying our weekly trips to Elm Court. In art we created our own stencil design, we cut them out and made unique prints using different paints. We also enjoyed a local walk to the playground where we practised our road safety skills and compared the different types of vehicles we could see.



Purple Class

Purple Class have had a positive and productive week, continuing to explore our 'London' topic through songs, images, symbols, props and familiar landmarks. The children particularly enjoyed using different media like paint and crayons to decorate buses and post boxes. Purple Class have also enjoyed taking part in their first cooking activity. They have been developing their social and physical skills by working in small groups to cut cucumbers and spread butter to make cucumber sandwiches.



Butterfly Class

Over the last week, Butterfly Class have enjoyed a wonderful music session filled with instruments, props, costumes and dancing. We have also continued to warmly welcome our new friends to the class and support them as they settle into their new environment. The children were engaged during a new massage story, showing a range of responses and reactions as they experienced the different stages of the story. It was lovely to see them exploring and responding to the sensory experiences in their own individual ways.



Silver Class

This week, the pupils in Silver Class had lots of fun during gymnastics, where they explored creative movement and developed their balance, coordination and body awareness. The pupils followed a variety of instructions and were encouraged to move their bodies in different ways, supporting their ability to listen, follow directions and respond to movement cues. The pupils also took part in activities focusing on turn-taking, fine motor skills and balance. They practised waiting for their turn, sharing resources and engaging positively with their peers, whilst developing their hand control, coordination and physical skills. It has been a lovely week of learning through movement, play and interaction!



Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class we have been working on solving money problems. We have worked out how much change we will get back from different amounts and how to pay for multiple items. We have also continued with our trips to Elm Court and have been partaking in music and art sessions there.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have been busy exploring various structured and unstructured activities. Some of the children have focused on developing their tripod grip. They have also been writing the names of the toys and resources that they have spotted. Ladybirds have enjoyed exploring and tasting different textures of food while making eggless biscuits during their cooking session.
