Red Class are excited to be back in school. We have really enjoyed seeing all our friends again and completing our physical programmes. Our new sensory story is about a trip to the circus.



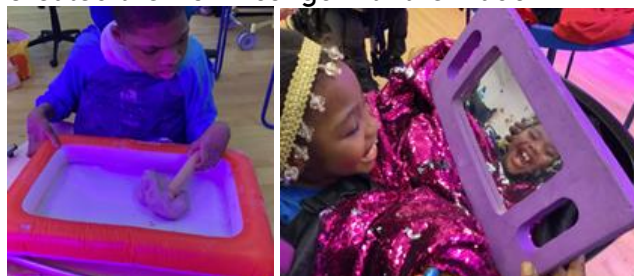
Yellow Class
