We have started the term by completing colour sorting tasks. The children have been able to maintain focus and extend their attention to be able to engage for longer periods.

We have also used fly swotters to create firework paintings focusing on the movement word 'splat'.

We have also watched the effects of gravity! We have used squeezy bottles and pipettes with watered down paint to create 'ramp paintings. The children were intrigued to see the paint drip down the ramp and magical lines appear.

Happy New Year from Rainbow Class! We have had a great first week back and have been enjoying seeing our friends and doing some good learning. On Monday, we made some thank you cards for the choir that came to sing to us before the Christmas break. We have started our new topic of 'My Movements'. We have enjoyed creating movement using parachutes and switch activated toys that move. Our favourite activity has been making cornflour gloop. We liked mixing the ingredients together and then watching it run through our fingers.

It was great to welcome Purple Class back after the holidays! We have all settled in well and have enjoyed exploring our new topics. In *My Thinking* this week, we started learning about shapes. We made our own shape monsters by requesting the shapes that we wanted our monsters to be and using shape cutters to cut these shapes out of playdough. We used our fine motor skills to add arms, legs and scary eyes.

Butterfly Class have had a positive start to the new year. We are enjoying our new topic about **Movement**, exploring how we can move our bodies and what movements we can make in different ways. We have also engaged in *Mental Well-Being Week* and enjoyed activities including dancing, massage stories and creating photo frames with a favourite photo.

Bumblebee Class has started really well the New Year. We have been managing well our routines with the practice of threading and using our hands to model playdough.
