Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have continued practising their phonics by making CVC words. We had a fun time during Whippersnappers www.thelivityschool.co.uk

listening to the digeridoo and communicating which instrument was our favourite. The children were able to take part in a pretend egg splat activity in an Attention Autism session using fly swatters and shaving foam. It was great to see them turn taking with more independence. The children also made biscuits and they were able to squeeze the icing to decorate them.



Rainbow Class

This week in Rainbow Class we liked creating our own picnic. After trying different sandwich fillings, we decided honey was our favourite so we practised making sandwiches using honey. We then decided we would need a drink to go with our sandwiches so we made our own lemonade. First, we squeezed the juice out of our lemons before adding sugar that had been dissolved in water. We then added water to taste. Finally, we sieved out the seeds and drank it. It was very sour but we still enjoyed it.



Green Class

This week in Green Class we have been practising our sharing and turn taking skills. We

have enjoyed trying out different games with our friends. Green Class have also enjoyed learning about Chinese New Year; exploring the ingredients and props related to the celebrations. We also liked creating lanterns to decorate the classroom with.
