#### **Red Class**

In 'My Cognition', the pupils are learning to cause an effect on their environment with increased independence. In 'My Communication', the pupils are using individualised communication strategies to express themselves. Some pupils are using eyegaze devices to make requests.



#### **Yellow Class**

Yellow Class children this week enjoyed a dough disco session. They explored and manipulated dough whilst listening to music with different rhythms. They also tracked the lights on our new sensory toys in class. We celebrated 'International Forest Day' with natural resources connected to forests.



#### **Pink Class**

Pink Class had a wonderful time last week dressing up in our favourite costumes and wigs for Comic Relief. We have been showing excellent communication throughout the week, particularly in our 'My Creativity' and 'How My World Works' sessions. We used our PECS books and communication books to make choices and requests.



#### **Blue Class**

This week Blue Class enjoyed preparing fruit salad during our cooking lesson. The pupils washed their hands and prepared all the fruit. We decorated our fruit salad with strawberries to celebrate Red Nose Day.



#### **Orange Class**

The phonics sessions in Orange Class have been helping pupils to develop their confidence to read. The pupils have been making great progress. Some of the pupils have moved from identifying sounds to blending them in order to make CVC words.



#### Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have been exploring the texture of playdough made with flour and cocoa powder. They have been using Easter egg shape cutters to press down onto the scented playdough. The children have also been developing their fine motor skills by completing mark making tasks. The class have been focused on problem solving activities such as completing puzzles, sorting colours and shapes.



#### **Rainbow Class**

Rainbow Class put their road safety learning to the test this week. We went on a walk around the local roads and made sure we looked right, then left, then right again to make sure it was safe to cross. We constantly looked along the road to ensure we were safe. We also enjoyed seeing some beautiful daffodils along the roadside.



#### **Green Class**

Green Class had lots of fun completing red activities for Red Nose Day. We dressed in red, made red playdough and decorated biscuits with red icing. This week we have also enjoyed mixing bicarbonate of soda with vinegar and washing up liquid to create lots of bubbles and fizz. We helped to create the mix and attended really well to the reaction.



#### **Purple Class**

In Purple Class this week we enjoyed our Capoeira session. We have been learning different moves with our arms and legs to do in time with the music. Purple Class also enjoyed their trip to Brockwell Park Greenhouses. We were happy that there was no rain this week which meant that we could explore the gardens and plant some strawberries!



#### **Butterfly Class**

Butterfly Class celebrated Red Nose Dasy with lots of activities. The children enjoyed exploring red shredded paper and red objects. We built with red construction resources, made patterns using sponges with red paint and also made red collages with various kinds of red textures.



#### **Bumblebee Class**

In Bumble Bee Class this week we celebrated Red Nose Day and painted some red noses on sheets. We have also been working on our fine motor skills, squeezing pegs and posting pom poms.





#### **Gold Class**

This week Gold Class pupils decorated a paper plate to make a penguin, a character in our story 'The Runaway Iceberg'. The pupils followed the steps to complete the task and used their preferred communication system to request the tools and colours they needed. The pupils also followed instructions to make pizza and used kitchen equipment to complete the task. The class really enjoyed making and tasting pizza.



#### Silver Class

In our maths lesson this week Silver Class have been learning how to count money and how to identify and define different coins. We've also been doing lots of work on how to add together different coins. During snack time the children were encouraged to buy their favourite foods using the money provided to them.





#### **Unicorn Class**

This week in Unicorn Class we have been forming our own stories using past and present tense with the help of sentence prompts. We have also been building our life skills by learning to do laundry!
