Blue Class

This week Blue Class started working on an **Art Project.** Today the workshop was themed "**Forest**". The pupils worked individually drawing, colouring, cutting, sticking and using their creativity to represent all the elements of a forest with trees, birds, rivers and animals. The pupils enjoyed the activity and they created a sculpture representing a big tree with roll paper and leaves. In the end they performed as a team and had the opportunity to be part of the "**Forest**". Welcome back Blue Class!!



Orange Class

In this first week back after Easter holiday the children in Orange Class got very busy with the Art project form Create. Duing this session with an external company, children had lots of fun and engaged with the activities, each according to their ability. It was great to see all children engaging with the activities.



Ladybird Class

Ladybirds Class have enjoyed being back at school. We made 'volcanoes' by mixing bicarbonate of soda and vinegar with washing up liquid. The children could use symbols to comment on the bubbles and request for more materials to mix. We have also enjoyed Whippersnappers again. We also made enchiladas and did very well tracing letters and making marks using the 'Busythings' program.



Rainbow Class

The children have had a wonderful break and have returned to school well rested and ready to learn and have fun. We are going to focus on 'Paddington Bear' and 'Room on the Broom', linking these two stories to our theme 'Journeys'. We also started our phonics programme and will be implementing this during this term.



Green Class

This week in Green Class we have enjoyed exploring ultra violet light using UV torches to see what glowed under the light. We also enjoyed mixing UV paint into shaving foam to look at how the paint glowed as we created different patterns.



Purple Class

This week in Purple Class we have been using colourful semantics. We had a picture of us doing different things and we were building sentences about it. We are also learning how to identify and write our names.



Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class the children were back to school and they welcomed Freddie back to class. The children started a new topic about Journeys and will be exploring this in a variety of ways. They have started by exploring journeys through their senses.



Bumblebee Class

Bumblebee Class has had a lovely start to the Summer Term. We have had an amazing first day back as we followed our routine so well. We are exploring a new story called 'The journey'. We have listened to it and touched props to follow along the story.

We have also made wings on a butterfly using our hands with red, blue and yellow colours. It has been wonderful to be back at school.



Gold Class

Pupils in Gold Class have settled down nicely after the Easter Holidays. This term our topic is 'Journeys'. We have been working on transport and modes of transportation. Pupils are also working on their writing and reading skills during our Phonics Sessions, and shapes.
