These activities not only celebrated the Easter season but also supported fine motor development, cognitive skills like counting and number recognition.

This week in Orange class the children enjoyed using their skills playing basketball during their P.E session with their peers and had fun doing so. They also enjoyed their art session making beautiful pictures using different art materials.



Bumblebee Class

This week, Gold Class focused on writing and sequencing sounds to make words. The pupils enjoyed phonics lessons and engaged in activities to recognize the sounds they have learnt this term. Pupils completed activities during 'My Communication' lessons and practiced writing and matching words to pictures of our story.

Green Class have been enjoying exploring the resonance board. We have been seeing how our body movements can effect change on our surroundings.
