Red Class

This week Red Class children had a great time sharing games with Green Class and also joined Yellow Class slime exploration having a lovely time in the sensory room themed the Rainforest. Red Class children are making friends within the school community.



Yellow Class

Yellow Class children this week have continued doing activities in the sensory room themed as a Rainforest. They connected the bubble tube and explored different smells, and textures, and sang songs together. They also played with slime and manipulated paint with strings, beads, and other materials to create amazing pieces of art work



Pink Class


In Pink Class this week we've been using switches to indicate our choices about what we want on the computer. We've also been working hard on our fine motor skills, building up block towers and threading string through hoops. In art we've been continuing to investigate the rainforest and have been looking at different birds that live there and have been sticking colourful feathers onto templates to make our own 'birds of paradise'.



Blue Class

This week Blue Class was introduced to 3 different working stations to pupils and they were encorauged to move independently to their allocated stations.

As part of their activities the pupils focused in fine motor skills, pencil control and matched 2D shapes, circles, squares and triangles.



Orange Class

This week in Orange Class, pupils learned about 2D shapes. They enjoyed listening to songs about shapes, playing with some and counting sides and corners. Pupils were also encouraged to sort shapes in 2,3 or 4 groups according to their abilities and really engaged with this task. We also developed and consolidated our social skills through a turn taking game. Pupils learned how to play with a toy and pass it to their peers with some support.

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Ladybird Class

This week the children in Ladybird's Class have worked hard on their throwing and catching skills. We threw soft balls onto a Velcro target and used beach ball to practise catching. We worked on extending our attention skills by creating an orange and black striped tiger in Attention Autism. The children were able to watch the demonstration and then draw their own tiger stripes in orange rice on a black tray or on tiger silhouettes. We also made choices of colour and tools to make jungle scenery.



Rainbow Class

Children in Rainbow Class have been working on phonics and using ICT to help us read. We have been enjoying going to the library to fo 'reading for pleasure'. We look forward to reading a new story about the environment.



Green Class

Children in Green Class this week have tried out our new Glow construction cubes. They enjoyed watching and making the colours change through rolling and turning the cubes over. They also enjoyed stacking the cubes and trying to match the colours.



Purple Class

Purple Class have been very creative this week doing addition, threading and using foam balls during thinking lessons. We have also been making wraps using a range of ingredients from icing to sprinkles during cooking class.



Butterfly Class

In Butterflies this week we have been using UV lights and equipment to support our visual attention. In Maths we have been working on object permanence and have looked for our favourite items in shredded paper, sand and scarves amoungst other things. We became very excited when we found them.



Bumblebee Class

This week in our Art session Bumblebee Class has explored cutting and sticking different coloured tissue paper to make fruits for Handa's Surprise story. Children have been engaged and enjoyed very much this sticking experience.

Over the week, we have also been interested in bying snacks at our Tuck Shop in class. Children have had the opportunity to choose from their favourite snacks exchanging money for it. It was a good learning week.



Gold Class

This week, pupils in Gold Class have been learning all about Hot environment and the Sahara desert. We have used different ICT's to comment on what we have learnt. Pupils continue developing addition skills and solving equations. In our cooking lesson, we read and followed a recipe to make "Stamped cookies" with the footprint of our favourite animal on them.



Silver Class

This week Silver Class pupils have been learning to differentiate between the jobs of a farmer, doctor, firefighter, builder, teacher, and cook. Pupils have been match ing simple descriptions of work that people do with the names of those jobs.



Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class our pupils have been investigating different modes of transport. We have built parachutes and tested them with different weights, we have also had a paper aeroplane competition to see who's can fly the longest distance!!
