We've been getting creative in our cooking lessons this week in Pink Class. We made a delicious fresh salsa with tomato, onion, coriander and lime which we whizzed up in the blender and ate with some tortilla chips. Yum! In music we've been practicing responding to "stop" and "go" by playing musical chairs.



Blue Class

This week Blue Class has worked with "Zones and Regulations" as part of their daily routine. This is used for them to understand their feelings. Identifying their own feelings is part also of our theme "ourselves" in which we are working on this term.



Orange Class

Orange Class have continued to learn about themselves, focusing on senses. Children tasted, smelled, and touched different items. They enjoyed this activity and some were able to match words to pictures of the items that they tasted.



Rainbow Class

Rainbow and Silver Classes opened the "Tuck Shop" this week. We had a very good and successful morning where many students from every class came to partake in the activity and we made £34. We look forward to doing this activity every Wednesday. We also made porridge, where we followed a cooking schedule promoting independence.
