#### Red Class

This week, Red Class have been focused on our physical development. We have been walking around the school in our walkers and using the standing frames during activities and movement sessions on the mats.

#### Yellow Class

Yellow Class children participated in small group activities on the mats to get to know each other better and share different toys. The children have been looking at fairy lights and manipulating them with adult support. They also took turns with other toys. During those sessions children expressed themselves with body movements, gestures and vocalizations.



#### Pink Class

We've been doing lots of fantastic hard work this week in Pink Class. We've been practising our sharing and turn-taking in Me and My Community sessions. In My Thinking we've been working at developing our fine motor skills by using tweezers to count frogs in the pond. We're all really enjoying our story, Leaf

#### Blue Class

This week Blue Class worked with Phonics. They are developing their skills and are memorizing the alphabet. The letter T is our focus at the moment. As part of the activity, the pupils are asked to choose any symbol with the letter T and identify an object in the tray that corresponds with the letter T.



#### Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, children continued to learn about our body and we were very amazed to see children matching body parts to clotting items independently. We also had opportunities to develop our fine motor skills

by using paint brushes and paper plates to make poppies for Remembrance Day or following templates to build towers with Lego.



### Ladybird Class

Ladybird Class have focused on representing our face and bodies this week. In maths, we sorted red and yellow to make a play dough 'man' with two eyes, two arms and two legs. The children watched the demonstration and then completed the activity in their own way. In art, we watched how to create a face and then chose different colours to create our own multicoloured paintings. In the role play shoe shop the children gave money to their friends to put in the till.



### Rainbow Class

In Rainbow Class, part of our daily progression towards self-regulation and acknowledging other people's feelings is to talk about our own feelings. The pupils in our class have been building up the confidence and also the vocabulary to say how they feel and also what they want.



### Green Class

Green Class are sharing their new story "Shark in the Park on a Windy Day". The pupils are feeling dried leaves in their hands, also the breeze from our fans and requesting a variety of props using their communication method. They especially like looking through the telescope.

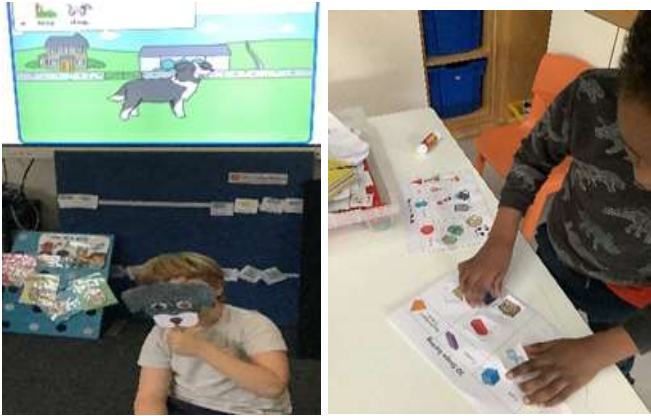


### Purple Class

We have also been matching numbers and sequencing numbers using puzzles. We have had a few amazing attention autism this week where children anticipated the objects that came out of the bucket.

Our Bumblebees have also experienced different textures during Relaxation time.



### Gold Class

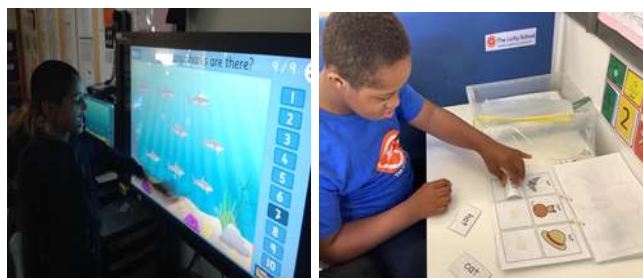

### Silver Class

This week Silver Class have been looking at addition and subtraction, securing our understanding of place value to 10 and developing an understanding of numbers beyond that, including counting in 2s, 5s and

10s. We have also had regular practical lessons in measuring and looking at shapes and patterns too.



### Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class we have been broadening our vocabulary with regards to animals and their habitats, matching animals to the correct habitat. We have also been answering questions on what animals need from their habitats and why!!!
