#### Red Class

Red Class enjoyed our journey to Greece this week. We explored the world of Greek Myths in messy work, finding out about Medusa's snakes. We have been working hard in My Communication engaging in Intensive Interaction



#### Pink Class

This week in Pink Class we have been enjoying making some delicious pineapple and coconut smoothies during our cooking lesson when we implement our communication methods to express our choices. We all did fantastically well at following the recipe and following instructions to use the blender. During My Thinking lessons, we have continued our excellent work at identifying 2D shapes.



#### Yellow Class

Yellow Class this week have been working on "Zones of Regulation" with the Speech and Language Therapists. They enjoyed a session where they could explore sensory resources related to the Green Zone (Calm). They explored different items and textures related to the sea such as seashells, sand, water and different sea animals while listening to the sounds of the waves.

## Blue Class

This week Blue Class finished the third workshop delivered by the Create team. The theme was the Environment and the last workshop was focused on was **"Under the Sea"**. Pupils used their creativity to make a jelly fish using an umbrella and various different materials. They used the jelly fish to create a small performance representing the world under the sea.



## Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, our shopping trip was a success. Children had opportunities to develop their awareness of danger and learned about road safety. In relation to our "My thinking" focus this term, the pupils also familiarised themselves with the use of money.



## Ladybird Class

We have been using our ball skills to play with our friends this week: passing the ball by rolling, throwing or kicking. We have been sorting colours and learning to count different quantities by using number lines to support us to understand what numbers mean. In cooking, we made Guatemalan hotdogs. The children used verbs such as 'mash' and 'squeeze' combined with nouns to make 2 key word phrases. We also used our PECS books to ask for rolls and sausages to make our hotdogs. We are continuing to read our class story about a bus journey in Guatemala, the children have been counting passengers from the story, onto their buses this week.



## Rainbow Class

We had a good week in Rainbow Class. The pupils enjoyed many activities throughout the week. Some of our pupils tried different food for the first time during cooking. We also started work on learning about multiplication and grouping numbers. This week we will begin going to Elm Court School for weekly assembly on Friday.



## Green Class

This week in Green Class we really enjoyed making playdough. We followed instructions to make the dough and made choices such as adding colour and scents to our mixes. We then used the dough to practice our fine motor skills.



## Purple Class

This week in Purple Class we have had been working a lot on My Communication forming words with the sounds that we already know and using colourful semantics. In My Thinking we have been counting objects and adding one more to a certain number of objects.



## Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class the children have taken a train journey around the school and even picked up passengers to hop on! The children have worked on artwork to develop a class display sharing our focus story.



## Bumblebee Class

Bumblebee Class has had a brilliant week! We have had a great time exploring food during Fun with food session. We have tasted and crushed various cereals with cup and with our fingers. It was really fun! Bumblebee Class has also had a fantastic Music session as the children were able to hear their voices using a microphone. They also played the guitar. We continued to practice our shared reading with sound books. We have started to match sounds to the correspondent props.



## Gold Class

Gold Class is taking the train to visit different cities in Spain. We took the train to Barcelona and made a Picasso portrait. Pupils pretended to take the train and solved additions and subtractions mathematical problems. Gold Class pupils are using different communication systems to request games and comment on activities. We followed a recipe to make a Spanish omelette during our cooking lesson.

### Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class we have been working on terms such as more/less, taller/shorter and categorising objects based on measurements. We have also been matching fractions to percentages!!
