This week Blue Class enjoyed the visit of our Ocupational Therapists colleagues who delivered a great workshop in Zones of Regulation. The pupils learned the difference between the Green Zone (calm, happy) and the Yellow Zone (excited, confused). They learned the symbols, sign language and the emotion related to each one of the Zones. We are looking forward to the next workshops. Well done Blue Class.



Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, we developed our in-hand strength whilst following templates to build towers with Lego. Children worked very well and were able to reproduce towers with up to five pieces independently. Children really enjoyed taking part in this activity.



Ladybird Class

Ladybirds Class have counted objects into small groups, built towers and enjoyed singing number rhymes this week. They were able to anticipate key events in the songs. Some children walked to the shop to buy ingredients for our cooking. We were so impressed with how sensibly the children walked and chose and paid for our shopping. Rainbow Class

This week we have been working on comprehension, focusing on reading skills such as retrieval. The children have been reading various stories that they have chosen to read. Children are using their developing skills to read and also to build confidence.



Green Class

This week in Green Class we have been focusing on sharing with our peers. We have been playing ball games and taken turns sharing bubbles. We have also been doing a lot of physical work on the mats with our peers and enjoyed a music session with Kim.







Butterfly Class

This week in Butterflies we have made edible paint. We liked mixing the different colours we chose through the yogurt or cornflour and water mix. We pressed paper onto our marks to create paintings.



Bumblebee Class

This week Bumblebee Class has worked a lot on their communication. Children have had various opportunities to choose items they liked during Communication sessions. We have also explored different activities through our free flow sessions and Bumblebees have shown a lot of interest in mark making, in exploring books with adults and playing with musical instruments.



Gold Class

This week, Gold Class has been working on developing and securing concepts of addition and subtraction. We have practice our Phonics lessons using the Sounds-Write Phonics Programme.

Children in Gold Class learnt about how doctors help us and dramatized a GP Surgery with promts to encourage their language.

Silver Class are taught phonics for 20 minutes just before lunch time everyday and is

extremely beneficial for reading and spelling development at this stage of your child's education. We have refered to the sounds that your child has already been taught in previous years and have added to that bank of sounds by introducing other ways of making that same sound. 


Unicorn Class
