# 3. Additional Speech and Language Therapy

Outcome: Pupils have personalised methods of communication including AAC

Evidence: Communication progress data, additional equipment for individual pupils

#### 4. Music Therapy

**Objective:** To provide strategies for supporting pupils and develop sustainable interventions. Pupils referred continue to respond positively to this support.

**Outcome:** Targeted intervention strategies for pupils. Increased engagement in the curriculum. Support to develop language or communication skills. Support for emotional needs.

**Evidence:** Progress data, music therapy reports and staff teams

# 5. Movement Therapy

Outcome: Improved communication skills, improved emotional regulation

**Objective:** To provide personal resources to support identified pupils' specific needs **Outcome:** Specific equipment bought for targeted pupils – eg Big MAC Switch.

Increased engagement with others.
