Red Class have been on a journey to Jamaica this week. We enjoyed exploring the sounds, tastes and smells of the country. We have been developing our shared reading, exploring sensory stories and story massage together. We are working hard in My Cognition, using touch and switches to cause effects.



#### Pink Class

In Pink Class this week we've begun our new story, 'Whatever Next', and have enjoyed colouring in some of the characters from the story. In phonics we've been thinking hard about the letter 't', and have been looking at all the different things that begin with that letter.



#### Yellow Class

Yellow Class this week have started to make decorations to celebrate the King's Coronation. They are creating their own version of the Union Jack, crowns and bunting for the class. The children also continued working on their physio programs while doing different activities on the mats such as yoga and physibods.

## Blue Class

This week Blue Class have been getting into their normal routine. One of our strategies is to keep the Zones of Regulation workshops, so they can learn to self-regulate when necessary. The more we practice the more effective this will be.



## Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, our phonics session went very well. We had a recapitulation on the letter sound "m".

We also had our first session of Zones of Regulation and children engaged very well with the activities that helped them to relax and feel calm, given that we focused on the green zone.



## Green Class

This week in Green Class we have taken part in activities related to China as part of our *Journeys* topic. We created paint firework rockets and enjoyed pressing the switch to say 'go'. We also cooked a noodle dish and chose the ingredients we wanted to use.



## Ladybird Class

Ladybirds Class have enjoyed exploring the new topic *Journeys*. We shared our new story; the Barefoot Books version of "The Wheels on The Bus" which is based on a bus journey in Guatemala. The children used PECs to communicate for their favourite choices of props from the story.

We printed wheels and windows for bus pictures, with big and little squares and circles. We explored *things that go by* making cola fountains and bubble paintings.



## Rainbow Class

In Rainbow Class, we have been working on our story 'Room on the Broom'. We have continued to work on phonics, music and learning how to use kitchen utensils. For music, we listened to music from around the world and used drums and shakers to follow the beat and rhythm of the music.



## Purple Class

This week in Purple Class, children made some dough. They followed the instructions and mixed all the ingredients together. They had a great time using cutters and making 2D shapes. They have also enjoyed reading for pleasure choosing different books.



## Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class the children have enjoyed our big book story about a train journey. The children enjoyed exploring different props and going through the tunnel was a big highlight of the story! The children have worked well on their communication through various activities and have shown great engagement whilst having fun.



## Bumblebee Class

Bumblebee Class has had a brilliant week. We have enjoyed the experience of buttering our bagels at breakfast club. We have been touching and sorting big and small objects during maths session. We have really enjoyed our cooking lesson decorating pizza with different ingredients.



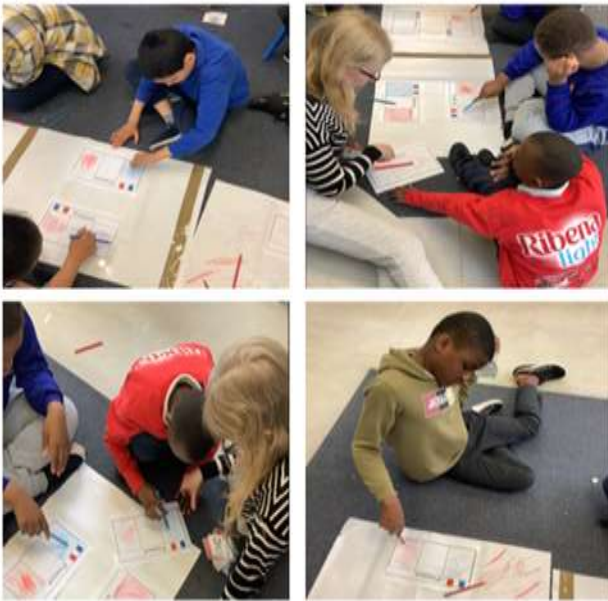
## Gold Class
