Red Class

Red Class enjoyed a trip to Hillside Gardens as part of 'Me and My Community' learning. We explored natural resources and listened to the birds and trains.



Yellow Class

Yellow Class children this week, have been exploring with their hands the glitter Gelli Baff seeing how it grows and changes when we add warm water. They also actively participated in the *Little Morris* sensory story helping the main character to find balls of different textures.



Pink Class

It's been another busy week in Pink Class. In art we did some excellent collaborative painting, where we painted to the tempo of different types of music. In cooking we made fruit smoothies, using some of the fruits from our story. They were delicious and we enjoyed drinking them at snack time!



Blue Class

This week the boys in Blue Class enjoyed their first lesson in the swimming pool. They got confident in the water and enjoyed exploring with the swimming. These movements will be helpful to support their balance, breath, conditioning and interaction and exercising generally.



Orange Class

Orange Class had a great week. Pupils' demonstrated their task focus and persistence when completing puzzles and threading activiteis. During 'My Communication sessions, children worked according to their ability. Whilst some were finding the correct vowels from a set of three to spell some words related to our story, others were spelling words with adult support.



Ladybird Class

In art, we watched colours change by spinning them in a salad spinner. We used key words to comment on how the paint mixed and moved. It was also wonderful to see the children working together to do this; sharing the paint and taking turns to make the salad spinner turn. We enjoyed used PECs to communicate for our favourite toys. Some children worked on their phonics; finding letters to match and working out which sounds they need to alter to change the word in the 'sound swap' activity.

Some children have started to learn about telling the time. Other children have matched one object to each number symbol to make the correct quantity of objects.

In cooking we made 'Cheese Roll-Ups'. The children were able to practise the verbs 'roll' and 'sprinkle' and requested for more cheese, using their PECs symbols.



Rainbow Class

In Rainbow Class this week, we have started our class reading book called *Goldilocks*. As such, we made some porridge in our cooking lesson. We practised measuring the ingredients so that it wasn't too sweet or too salty. It was just right. After it came out of the microwave, we added either raspberries or raisins and then ate it all up!



Green Class

Green Class have enjoyed creating and exploring a slime made with sweets. We microwaved them and added corn flour and icing sugar, which made a very sticky slime. We have also been continuing our look at changing seasons and this week considered Winter. We particularly liked making ice cubes and then experimented with them as they melted.



Purple Class

In Purple Class this week we explored our topic of 'Changes' through painting with ice. We observed the changes that happened as the ice melted and the colour transferred onto the paper. We made some beautiful patterns and shapes with our ice.





Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class we have been engaged in our interactive and sensory stories. Our sensory story took as to a very autumnal place with sounds and props to explore which we enjoyed. Our 'Fairground' interactive story lead us to the coconut shy where we tried to knock the coconuts down and make a big crash! Playtimes have been fun with some lovely sunshine some of us have been able to move around and explore working on our walking and taking steps.



Bumblebee Class

This week Bumblebee Class has been on a sensory walk to look for Autumn leaves to be aware of the changes in seasons. We have had an amazing music session following music rhythm with shakers and using a microphone to copy Teacher's sounds. We have also been engaged in our free flow sessions using role play as a way to promote our playing skills.




Gold Class

For our cooking lesson, we followed the recipe and sequenced the steps to make sequilhos (gluten free cookies) with the shape of leaves.

In maths lessons this week, Silver Class have been working on each children's individual target and they were learning how to add and subtract a matching number and also recognising 3D shapes. The children were happy and also engaged in the activities.
