Red Class

Red Class pupils have enjoyed spending time with peers and exploring gross motor activities outdoors as part of their learning in Me and My Community. Pupils have been using switches in My Cognition to activate toys and games, like the car track!





Yellow Class

This week, Yellow Class children have been doing sensory activities related to Christmas. They had fun in our class grotto where they explored all kinds of objects related to the winter season. They also enjoyed a session with the VI team in which they used their CENMAC devices to make choices and communicate preferences during play.



Pink Class

This week, Pink Class again had a wonderful walk over to Hillside Gardens park and the class brilliantly showed their learning on crossing the road safely. In our How My World Works sessions we made 'Autumn play dough', where we infused our play dough mixture with different smells and autumnal colours.





Blue Class

Last Thursday Blue Class went for an visit to Marks & Spencer to apply our knowledge of money and practise our skills in the areas of My Thinking, My Communication and My Community. The children followed a recipe to make toast with cheese and tomatoes for our cooking lesson. Pupils were engaged and

enjoyed the experience.



Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, My Thinking sessions went very well. We continued to develop our skills and confidence with numbers through different activities in accordance with our abilities. Children matched numerals quantities and vice versa. They also filled gaps on number lines, followed visual instructions to make specific sets of numbers and demonstrated their understanding subtraction. Pupils enjoyed taking part in these sessions and worked very well.









Ladybird Class

This week during science, the children made 'jelly slime'. We combined jelly, colouring and cornflour. The children commented using action words such as 'pull', 'squeeze' and 'roll' www.thelivityschool.co.uk

as they explored it. We have continued the theme of watching chocolate change as we melt it. This week we used the melted chocolate to make rocky road biscuits. The children used their communication skills to choose (vegetarian) marshmallows, raisins, biscuits or popcorn to add to their mixture. In art, we applied masking tape to paper and then painted over it. When we removed the masking tape we looked to see the resulting pattern. The children did well, holding the paintbrushes using a functional grip, and traced over the masking tape lines. In maths, we have continued practising using one number name (or symbol) for each object, as we count. The children have used a range of objects, including light up ducks and squeezy frogs to count as part of the number songs.



Rainbow Class

This week has been very exciting in Rainbow Class! On Monday, we went to the shop to buy some healthy snacks and then we went to a café to get some freshly made fruit juice. We walked there and back again and had a really lovely time!



Green Class

Green Class this week have enjoyed visiting Brockwell Greenhouses. We learnt about how things grow and explored different vegetables in the gardens and greenhouses.

We also have enjoyed following instructions to

create flapjacks this week.



Purple Class

In Purple Class we enjoyed our trip to Streatham Space this week where we participated in an immersive theatre performance. We had a lot of fun exploring different sensory objects related to Christmas. We particularly enjoyed seeing the snowfall and wrapping presents ready for Christmas!



Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class we have been working on our communication skills showing our preferences and making great choices. We have also been becoming more familiar with our objects of reference. More of our children went swimming and were making some independent movements in the water.



Bumblebee Class

In Bumblebee Class this week, we have been practising our fine motor skills using more

challenging activities i.e. new puzzles, coloured nuts and bolts and threading with patterns. The children have been really engaged during story time as we added some 'Fun with Food' ingredients related to the story. We have done shared reading using sound books too. We loved our new emotions activity with a Page of Picture stabiling the good.

with a Peppa Pig matching board.



Gold Class

This week, pupils in Gold Class have been reading the 'Funnybones' story. Pupils were able to identify and use visuals to describe the characters and the settings of the story. We are learning about the human body and matching parts of the skeleton. During our My Thinking lessons, pupils have been counting bones and matching numbers.



Silver Class

This week the children in Silver Class have been having fun in gymnastics – exploring creative movement. They have been following a variety of instructions and challenging their balance and co-ordination skills.







Unicorn Class

This week in Unicorn Class we have been using multiple choice to write a sequel to *The Zoo Vet* story we have been studying. We have also been investigating the changes in ourselves as we arow older!!
