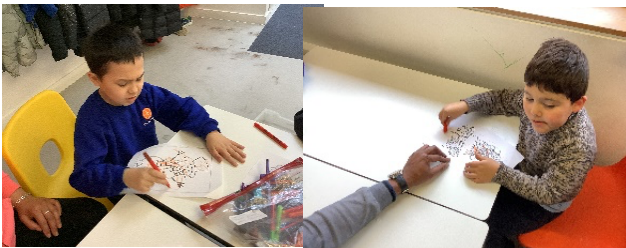
Green Class
