#### Red Class

We are concluding our work on *The Gingerbread Man* story. We used different bricks to build a bridge for the Gingerbread man to cross the river. Our story for the beginning of next half term will be *Jack and the Beanstalk*.



#### Pink Class

In art this week Pink Class have been building the homes from *The Three Little Pigs*; using straw and using bricks to print paint. We've also really enjoyed a sensory story. In PE we've been practising balancing and jumping.



#### Blue Class

This week Blue Class children have been working to develop their fine motor skills through a range of mediums, such as cutting out shapes in dough, making marks in lentils and overwriting letters using felt pens. Also this week, children have been re-enacting the story *The Three Bears and Goldilocks*.



#### Yellow Class

Yellow Class children have been decorating cards for Valentine's Day. We used paint with different textures. They have been also exploring all the props for the Sensory Story "The Bremen Town Musicians". They played some instruments and used BIGmacks to activate animal sounds when they appeared in the story.



### Orange Class

In Orange Class this week, we continued to learn about shapes in a more practical way. The children had another opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of simple shapes and colours by identifying and picking them from a group. During our cooking session, we had fun making our own pizzas using bagels.



### Ladybird Class

Ladybirds Class have had a good week. They really enjoyed their art lesson. We have also been having fun playing together. We have been learning to take turns in games such as stacking towers, using the stomp rocket and others, it was great!



### Rainbow Class

This past week we have been working on 2D and 3D shapes through various activities such as magnetic blocks, art and matching. We will continue to work on this topic next half term but we will be focusing on numbers and money to prepare for our weekly trip to Tesco.



### Green Class

Green Class have enjoyed sharing a disco with Yellow Class as part of our community lesson. The children switched the bubble machine and disco lights on by switch and played parachute games.



### Purple Class

During this week the children have continued to recognise and write their own name. We also have been going through our topic story "Goldilocks and the three bears" to develop our reading and comprehension skills. We have been using our phonics knowledge to write simple words, such as cat and dog.



## Butterfly Class

This week in Butterfly Class the pupils have explored fruits and created a healthy fruit salad. We have enjoyed experiences in the sensory room and engaged with the light box. Our new friends are settling well into the class too.

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
