We carried on with our seaside theme: counting different coloured boats and fish in maths and role play writing in the pretend ice cream shop.




Rainbow Class

Aka Pads, Pampers, diapers, nappies

Children are eligible for a continence assessment and may be eligible for products from the age of 5yrs. In some cases where the

child is a wheelchair user or unable to weight bear, this may be from 4yrs.
