
Blue Class

This week we read the book 'Dear Zoo'. The children were engaged and listened attentively to the story. After the story, they decorated their own lion. They were given a circle and different colours of paper to tear to create the face of a lion. The Occupational Therapist helped the children to practise their fine motor skills to complete the activity.



Orange Class

In our How My World Works lesson on materials and their properties, we were keen to sort items that were soft from those that were hard. We collected different objects and then used our communication systems to categorise them. We also learnt the Makaton symbol for 'hard' and 'soft'.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have demonstrated good pouring skills whilst carrying out an experiment called coffee ground fossils. They created imprints in the granules to make imitation fossils. Ladybirds have enjoyed making oat biscuits in the food tech room this week. They have shown good motor skills whilst mixing all the ingredients up and they were delicious.



Dragonfly Class

This week, Dragonfly children continued working on the sensory story 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. The children dressed like Mr. Wonka and chose their favourite props for the lesson. They also enjoyed their music session and joined the teacher whilst she was singing, by playing the guitar, the drums and the shakers. We also celebrated Red Nose Day by creating a collage with different textures.



Rainbow Class

Rainbow Class enjoyed Science Week at Livity and Elm Court. They were dressed in their lab coats, like actual scientists completing different experiments. They also met different animals and touched them.



Green Class

Green Class enjoyed doing experiments in My Cognition as part of Science Week. We particularly enjoyed participating in the bubble snake experiment. Green Class showed lovely realisation and anticipation during the experiment and did some great exploration of the bubble snakes they made.



Purple Class

This week Purple Class have been practising their fine motor skills. As part of our story 'Handa's Surprise' we have been cutting out fruit pictures and sticking them on to our baskets.



Butterfly Class

In the last week Butterfly Class have had a go at some experiments for Science Week. We enjoyed making cornflour slime and feeling how sticky it became as we explored it. We have also continued our food exploration, getting our hands into porridge and pasta.



Bumblebee Class

This week Bumblebee Class really enjoyed their art activities. We used different art media including collage materials, paint and glue to create very colourful pictures. We have also been doing activities to recognise emotions and matching the emotion to the picture.



Gold Class

This week, during our gardening lesson, the pupils in Gold Class have sown seeds to see how they grow. The pupils also followed the steps to complete a self-inflating balloon during our experiments. We are working on solving additions in our My Thinking lessons.



Silver Class

This week in Silver Class, one group worked on listening to letter sounds and creating CVC words. Whilst the other group explored extending the phonics code. The children learnt that the same sounds can be represented by different letter combinations, such as; "ai" in "rain" and "ay" in "play", "ea" in "seal" and "ee" in "tree."
