Ladybirds Class have had lots of fun finding and counting eggs as we have practiced Easter egg hunts. We have made hot cross buns, which were amazing! We made Easter crafts and we made sandwiches and planned a picnic. The children especially loved the picnic because they chose what food they would like to pack to take with them. They sat and socialized together as they ate.



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#### **Rainbow Class**

This week Rainbow Class have been reading one of our favourite stories "The Snail and the Whale". In art, we decorated eggs for the hunt in the school. We also toasted bagels for breakfast club, as part of teaching life skills. We enjoyed swimming and maths activities. This week in Butterfly Class the children enjoyed making bird nests in our cookery, the chocolate was a big hit!

Pupils also engaged in some Easter crafts and artwork and ended the week with a fun egg hunt!



#### **Bumblebee Class**

Bumblebee class has had a lovely week celebrating Easter and Spring. We have decorated Easter Eggs with glitter and different coloured pens. We have learned about the blue zone and loved to touch blue fidget toys. We have also explored our story The Three Little Pigs and this time we have learned how to sequence the story parts.



#### **Gold Class**

This week, Gold Class is learning about Easter and what it means. We are working on our numeracy skills by matching numbers and quantities and adding Easter Eggs to solve equations. Pupils are developing their phonics knowledge to read words and matching them with the picture. Pupils in Gold Class also use Colourful Semantics to construct and read sentences with growing independence.





**Silver Class** 

This week silver class have been ordering numbers and using our knowledge of number to say which numbers are more/less than a number by using visual and different objects. We have been focusing on deepening students understand of number with focus on numbers 1 to 20. During counting activities, we used toys (little ducks), which the students were able to match according to the numbers presented to them. The employment of interactive game (matching numbers and toys) helped the class to recognise the numbers and allocate them to the right amount to toys. Overall, children tried hard and are really beginning to recognise and understand the need for numbers. Well done everyone!!
