Red Class

Red Class have been developing their engagement through active learning activities. We have explored different resources suspended from A frames and the Little Room. As part of our learning in 'Me and My Community', we have explored the playground with peers from other classes.



Yellow Class

In Yellow Class this week our art has focused around our new story 'Mr Wolf's Pancakes'. We used paper plates and a range of different materials to create our own Mr Wolf. In our music sessions we have been showing brilliant communication and choice making. We have also enjoyed investigating different ways of making sounds.



Dragonfly Class

This week, Dragonfly children enjoyed celebrating pancake day with a sensory cooking lesson. They explored and mixed all the ingredients together, then chose their favourite toppings. They worked together to complete an activity by taking turns. The class also celebrated 'World Book Day' with sensory stories, costumes and visiting other classes to share activities with their peers.



Pink Class

In physical education, the children enjoyed engaging in various activities that focused on teamwork and skill development. They practised passing the ball to peers, learned how to kick with accuracy and worked together to play different games. A key focus was also following instructions, helping them understand when and how to act during specific moments of the activities.



Blue Class

In Blue this week we celebrated pancake day. The class enjoyed a group activity, decorating pancakes. They made choices around what they wanted to decorate it with and then stuck it on.



Orange Class

During our phonics lesson, we have been building up our vocabulary by learning and singing nursery rhymes. We also matched the actions of the ducks in the water and pretended they flew away over a hill and far away.



Ladybird Class

This week Ladybird Class have taken turns to create a butterfly using different colours of paint. They have been practising their number awareness by ordering numbered puzzles. Ladybirds have been developing their body strength as well as hand and eye coordination by throwing hoops on to the matching cones. They have also been celebrating pancake day by making home-made pancakes with raspberries and blueberries as a topping.

Rainbow Class

Rainbow Class have been learning to watch, listen and kick a ball. They had to stop the ball with their foot and then kick it back. We really enjoyed it.

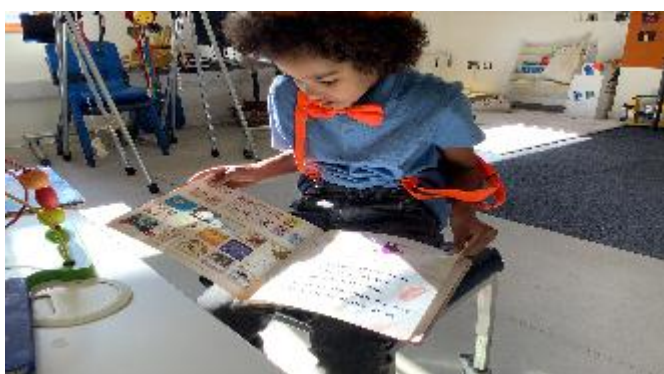
Silver Class
