The children used PECs to communicate for their favourite choices of pizza topping. We made seed bombs in outdoor learning and planted peas.

classes. Next week, Rainbow Class plan on going to a trip to the Horniman Museum and the children look forward to going out.



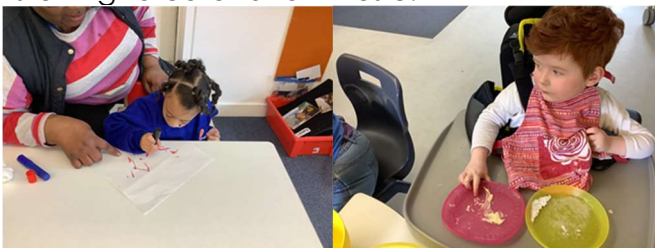
Purple Class
