Red Class

This week Red Class children were making 3D letters with sensory materials e.g. lentils, fur fabric and rice. They all took part in this activity making the letters of their names.



Yellow Class

Yellow Class children this week have expressed themselves through art. To celebrate our "Mental Well-Being week", they created different pieces of artwork with their preferred materials and colours. They used their preferred communication methods to make choices. They also actively participated in the "Bremen Town Musicians" sensory story by using all the props and making music themselves with their favourite instruments.

We've been welcoming Spring this week in Pink Class and planting some bulbs in the sensory garden. We've also been practising taking turns going down the slide. In phonics, we've been learning about the letter 't' and some of us have been working really hard at writing it out.

The pupils in Blue Class worked individually at their work stations using red paper and glue to produce a piece of artwork to express themselves and this cause.

Bumblebee Class has had a very busy week. We have learned about red zone feelings and we enjoyed looking for red fidget toys from the red bag. We have had an amazing experience going to Streatham Station cafe where we bought cake and shared it with each other. We have also learned a new story, 'The Three Little Pigs' and we loved touching the different materials that the houses in the story were made of.



Gold Class

This week, pupils in Gold Class have had a trip to the Battersea Park Children's Zoo. We had the chance to find animals from different environments and use different communication systems to say which animals we see. Pupils have been working on solving additions and subtractions and learning more about the ocean.



Silver Class

This week has been amazing with the children in Silver Class both indoors and outdoors. We started the week by learning some phase 2 CVC words in phonics, children learned how to listen carefully to identify the sounds they can hear within simple words and practise recognising and forming them. Others were able to read and write these words which was impressive. We also practised how to identify missing letters, example: pg, (pig), p _ t (pet), pn, (pan) etc. During morning circle, children had the chance to have a go at the three

letter words (pan, can, man, fan, tie, van, car, and so on). Some children were able to match words like can, fan, cup, car. While others were able to find the missing letters. They then moved to their workstation to practice in their new files.
