Red Class

Red Class have been completing their gardening jobs during their visit to Brockwell Greenhouses this week. The vegetables in our bed are growing well! We have also been stretching and trying new poses in our music and movement sessions.



Yellow Class

As we've welcomed Spring, Yellow Class have enjoyed the warmer weather in the sensory garden. We learnt about plant lifecycles and watered some of the plants in the garden. We had a great time in music this week, doing different types of movement to different songs.



Dragonfly Class

This week, Dragonfly children enjoyed their music lesson. They responded very well to the

props and the Intensive Interaction with the performers. The children have been decorating Easter eggs; exploring different materials and textures. They also enjoyed the gardening session where they touched and smelled all kinds of vegetables.



Pink Class

This week, we've been focusing on helping the children develop their motor skills by tracing their names. In phonics, the children have been exploring sensory phonics, using rice and ice as tactile bases for learning their letters sounds.



Blue Class

This week, Blue Class enjoyed cooking, preparing a fruit yoghurt cocktail whilst

practising their fine motor skills and learning about different fruits. They followed the steps of the recipe well and then enjoyed tasting their creations. We also continued reading '*The Disgusting* Sandwich', where the children matched the words, developing their vocabulary and supporting early literacy skills.



Orange Class

This week in Orange Class the children were given the opportunity to develop their turn taking skills. They played with their peers and had fun doing so. They sat and waited their turn at their chosen activity as they shared the resources.



Bumblebee Class

This week, Bumblebee Class really enjoyed the sensory story 'Ketchup on your Cornflakes' by Nick Sharratt. We practised exchanging symbols for our favourite item in the story. We also enjoyed an experiment where we used cotton wool, washing up liquid and milk to create a colourful explosion.



Gold Class

Gold Class enjoyed activities for Red Nose Day last Friday. The pupils explored different textures and found small objects hidden in red jelly. We kneaded dough and used a rolling pin to make red cookies. Then we baked them and ate some. During our gardening lessons, the pupils sequenced the steps to grow a plant and watered the garden cress that we planted last week, to take home.



Green Class

Green Class have been enjoying sharing a Holi sensory story together. We have been exploring different colours and materials. During the story we have also been working on our MOVE goals and practising different sitting positions.



Rainbow Class

Rainbow are working with Marcus an artist from the Victoria and Albert museum. They really enjoy using colours, paints and felt tips to make art works. They started off with dots and ended up with a masterpiece!



Purple Class

Purple Class have been practising their throwing skills in PE. We have been throwing hoops onto cones, beanbags into buckets and balls through a net. We then put these skills to the test in a game of basketball.



Butterfly Class

In the last week Butterfly Class have celebrated Red Nose Day at school by wearing red and engaging in red themed activities. We enjoyed the activities including exploring red rice pudding, red angel delight, and making a red collage art piece.
