



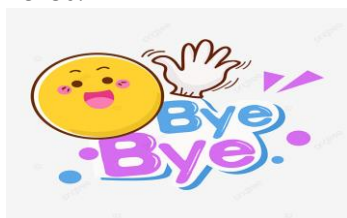
## The Livity School Weekly Newsletter

Green Class children have enjoyed TacPac this week and also learning to share and take turns. We played in our role play shop and made towers to push over together.



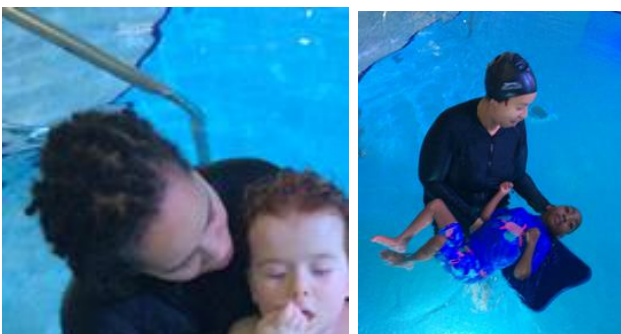
## Purple Class

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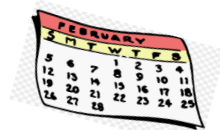
