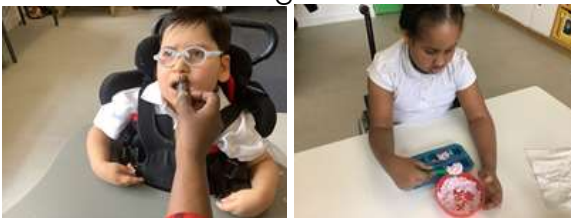
Rainbow Class
