Gold Class

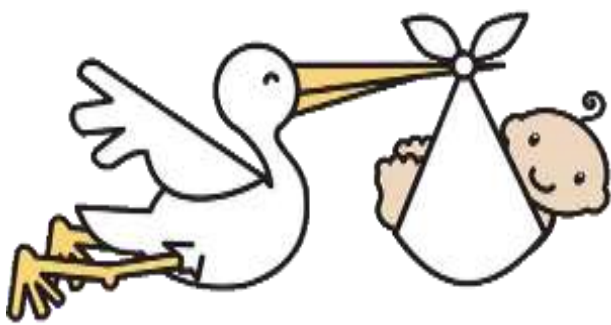
