#### Red Class

This week Red Class enjoyed making playdough and used it during our dough disco lesson. Children have been also learning about cause and effect by using switches to activate different toys. They also took part in Mr Ruffles Sensory Story "We are going to the bear hunt" exploring different props with hands and feet.



#### Pink Class

This week in Pink Class we've been considering the question 'what is a good friend?'. Then we practised turn-taking and sharing with each other which we did absolutely brilliantly. We've also been working hard in My Thinking, counting and adding numbers up to ten!



#### Yellow Class

Yellow Class children made kinetic sand. They explored each ingredient separately and then, they blended them moving their hands and fingers to create a new texture. We also received Mr. Ruffles' visit and the children actively participated in the "We are going on a bear hunt" Sensory Story. They also continued working and progressing on their physio programs using the equipment allocated to them.



#### Blue Class

This week Blue Class worked hard. Firstly working with the parachute in our PE class and also when we received Mr Ruffles as he told us the story about the bear hunt. They worked together as a team during both activities as well as following the instructions, working together experiencing their 5 senses in both activities. Well done. 😊



### Orange Class

In Orange Class this week during our personal care, children demonstrated great progress. Those who were reluctant to put the toothbrush in their mouth used it to brush dolls' teeth. During our communication lesson, children moved from matching pictures of four relating items to body parts to six pictures.



### Ladybird Class

Ladybirds Class have sorted and grouped objects into small quantities this week; building five towers of bricks, stacking groups of coloured objects with three in each set and posting different quantities. In outdoor learning we chose different colours to represent Autumn leaves. We also made 'happiness bags'. The children painted their bags to be ready for their photos and then we chose our favourite things to put inside.



### Rainbow Class

Rainbow Class went on a trip to Elm Court School this week to participate in a science lesson. The students were able to make scientific predictions and conduct an experiment about colours. We have been making links with Elm Court School to enrich our student's learning. We look forward to continue our partnership with Elm Court School.



### Green Class

Green Class this week enjoyed taking part in the story 'We are going on a Bear Hunt' with entertainer Mr Ruffles. The children felt the different props such as sticks and mud with their hands and feet.





## Purple Class

This week Purple Class have been learning how to count 1-20 using cubes and pegs. Much to our delight, the children have shown interest in our counting activities. In PE, the children have been practising animal movement and following two-step instructions during the lesson. It's been amazing to see the children demonstrating understanding of the movements.



## Butterfly Class

This week in Butterflies we have been making really good choices. We made microwave meringues and chose the colour, flavour and smell we each wanted to add. We then mixed and moulded the meringues before cooking them.



## Bumblebee Class

Bumblebee Class have had a fun learning week. We've learned to spread jam on toast and we've learned how to make a face with

banana and vegan chocolate buttons. We have also been using our now/next board to promote our understanding of what comes next.

Our Bumblebees have also experienced choosing times where they chose one object they liked most to play with. It was a very busy week!



## Gold Class

Gold Class has been learning about people who help us in the community. Children had fun identifying different jobs and using different communication systems to comment on how they help us and had read key words that help them assimilate concepts. We solved addition problems and practised counting by putting out numbered flames with a spray bottle.



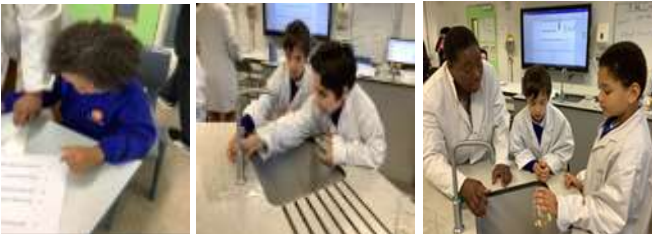
## Silver Class
