Red Class have been spending time with one another, communicating using touch, vocalisation and facial expression. Pupils have enjoyed shared reading experiences as part of our exploration of seasons.

This week in Orange Class, we really enjoyed our physical education session during which we practised our balance and developed our gross motor skills. During "My Thinking sessions, we looked at numbers. It was great to see children familiarising themselves with the different work areas in the classroom and working in small groups.



## **Ladybird Class**

This week Ladybird Class have continued exploring our new topic 'Changes'. We made volcanoes with bicarbonate of soda and vinegar. We also melted butter to make pineapple and raisin flapjacks. The children have been learning to walk to different learning locations around school and walked to the cooking room following a photo 'now and next'chart.

We have continued our story 'Anna's Amazing Multi-Coloured Glasses'; choosing and dressing up in different coloured glasses as part of the story.



### **Rainbow Class**

In Rainbow Class this week, we have looked at a range of different emotions and we thought about how they make us feel. We paired up pictures of some faces with cards describing different emotions to see what the emotions look like on other people.



## **Green Class**

Green Class have really enjoyed creating lots of change this week. We tested objects to see what would happen if we shined UV lights on them and made slime by mixing hair conditioner and cornflour.



## **Purple Class**

This week in Purple Class we enjoyed learning how to measure through a maths baking story. We learnt how to identify the different equipment we might need to bake a cake through using words such as long, short, big and small. We also did some great mixing and pouring which resulted in a delicious cake at the end!



# **Butterfly Class**

This week in Butterfly Class the children were happily exploring in their various morning activities with treasure baskets and cause and effect equipment. We really enjoyed our music session with Kim vocalising, playing instruments and using technology. We participated in communication games and had lots of fun.



## **Bumblebee Class**

Bumblebee Class has had a brilliant week. In our literacy session, we have chosen sound books to do our shared reading and we used symbols and Makaton signing. We have been exploring our hand skills with some of our wooden puzzle boards. We got a creative 'Fun With Food' session using different cereals glued onto paper to make an Autumn leaf for our Autumn class display.



#### **Gold Class**

Pupils in Gold Class have been working on the changes we can see in Autumn. Children are using different communication systems to comment on the colour of the leaves. During our cooking lessons, we followed a recipe to make bean salad and counted ingredients and quantities. We enjoyed healthy eating!



### Silver Class

This week in Silver Class the children were getting familiar with their new time table, regristration and classes. They have also been learning how to interact with the white board by dragging their own names to the correct column. We have been concentrating on settling the children into school life and ensuring that they feel happy and secure. The children were very engaged with the art session as they coloured in different stages of plant growth.

Aka Pads, Pampers, diapers, nappies

Children are eligible for a continence assessment and may be eligible for products from the age of 5yrs. In some cases where the child is a wheelchair user or unable to weight bear, this may be from 4yrs.
