World Book Day is Thursday 7th March. On this day the pupils can bring in their favourite book to share with their class and dress in the costume of their favourite book character.

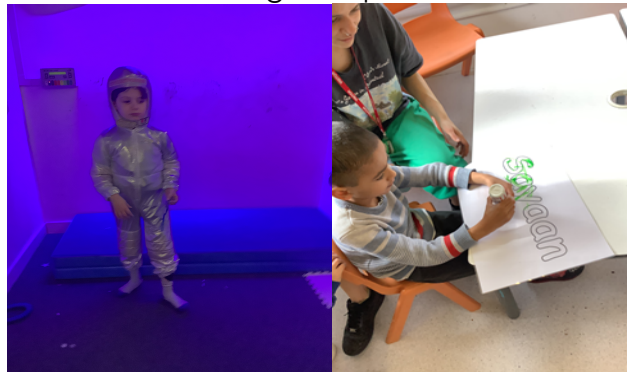

space. In our morning group work some of the pupils have begun trying to trace their names and then matching their photo to their name.



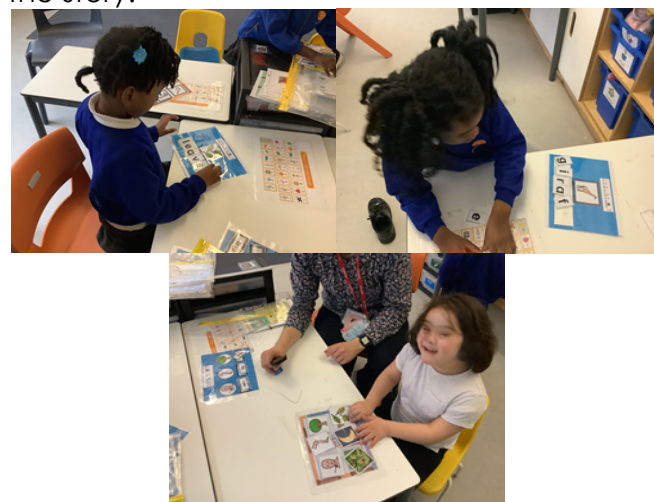
Yellow Class

We've continued our story 'My Journey in Space' this week and we communicated for the different story resources very well. We loved dressing as astronauts and role playing being in

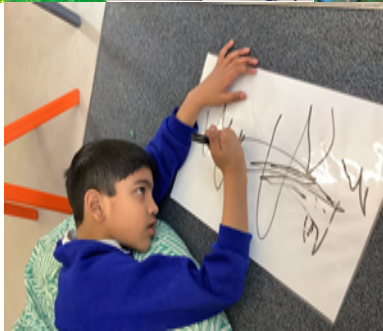
Orange Class

In the functional skills session we worked on throwing and catching and experiencing hot and cold. The children responded with happiness and excitement to the colourful fan.

This week Bumblebee Class have had an amazing art session using pink tissue paper and glue to create pigs as part of our 'The Three Little Pigs' story. Silver Class

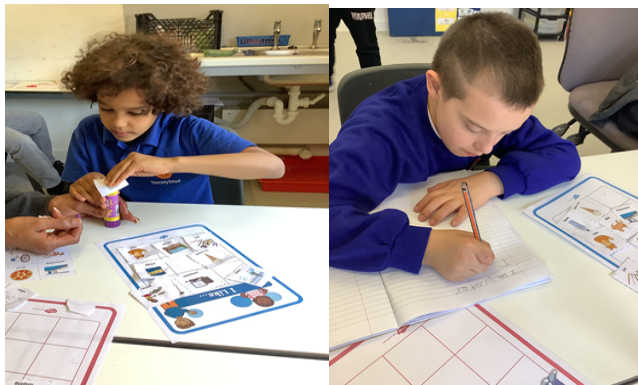
