School News

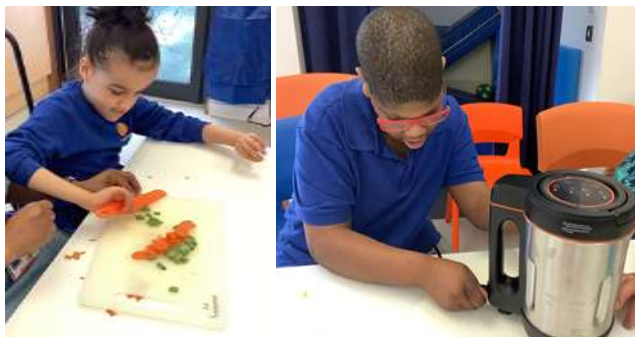

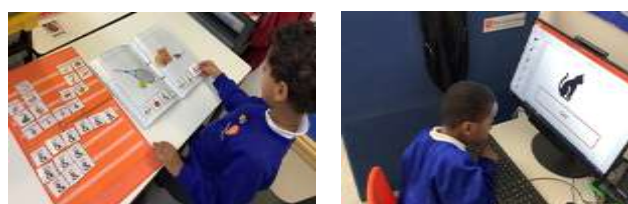
Yellow Class
