We also focused on consolidating children's ability to turn take by encouraging them to sit around the table, play with a toy then pass it to their peer. They are becoming familiar with the activity and this will help to develop their social skills.

Ladybirds Class have particularly enjoyed exploring our new role play shoe shop and spa this week. The children were very motivated by using switches to operate the foot spa, massager and bubble machine. They were very focused using the UV writing tablet in the multisensory room and have continued to practise fine motor skills by manipulating and rotating smaller objects to complete a task.

We had a good week back and settled in very well. We worked on shapes in our maths lesson and learned about their properties. We look forward to another good half term.

Welcome back to Bumblebees 🐵.


We have had a fantastic first week back as we made playdough at our cooking lesson, pouring flour and adding oil, water and cinnamon and mixing. It was really fun!


Unicorn Class
