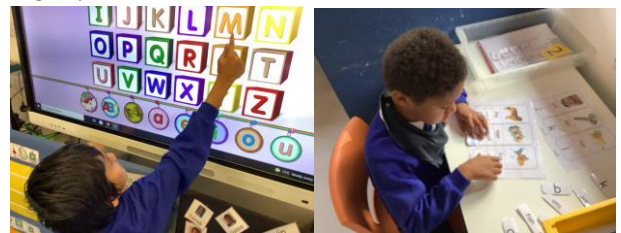
## Green Class

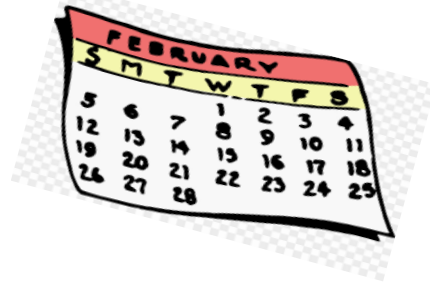
