




Butterfly Class Newsletter

Dear parent/carer, we hope everyone has had an enjoyable holiday and we are looking forward to a busy Spring term for Butterfly Class with lots of learning and fun!

This term ...

We are continuing our class topic '**Making Things**' this term and then we will move on to

'The **Seaside**' the children will be exploring the topic through sand and water play activities.

The topic will include learning about the creatures in the sea, making models and producing

various creative art work. We will also link to their chat books.



Class reminders...

- We would like to give a friendly reminder about the routines in Butterfly class; home school books should be kept in school bags and will be checked daily. Please remember to read daily in case of any messages and use to communicate with the class team.
- We would like to encourage the use of chat books, use the chat book to engage with your child about what they have done at school. Please use at home in the same way and



remember to send to school each week. We would love to see the children's news from home in their chat books, we can help them to share it with their friends.



- We will have a physical session each day so please ensure your child is wearing comfortable clothing i.e. jogging bottoms or leggings instead of jeans (especially on Tuesdays and Thursdays). Swimming is on a Monday. Swimming sessions are normally alternated between the children, so they might not be swimming every week. However, if there are children absent or not able to swim your child may get more opportunities to swim so please send your child's swimming things in weekly. PE is on **Tuesdays**, and Dance on a **Thursday**.



- Please remember to send in extra clothes [tops, bottoms, vests, socks, tights, underwear etc.] for any unexpected accidents we can keep these in school. Please name **ALL** clothes and any other accessories you send in.
- Home activities will be given on a **Tuesday** and be stuck in the chat book; it will suggest activities to try at home with your child which link to their learning at school.
- Cooking sessions take place on a Wednesday, the children will often bring home a sample of what they have made, please return the tupperware that the cooking comes home in, so we can have it again for the next session.
